



Dr. Epperly's story about how an institution and a program has approached this tension, strove to learn from it, and pursues that journey and community conversations towards excellence...






Full Circle Health Story

 - 7 Fellowships
- \$56M/Budget; \$2M Margin (3.6%)









Lessons Learned From Our Journey



- It takes time
- Stay focused on mission and purpose
- Believe in your people and your community
- Don't become your own worst critics

- Stay positive
- Dial the program in overtime using performance improvement and quality measurements
